



### Exhibit Fees - \$5,000

Each exhibit space will include one 6' x 30" draped table and two chairs. No free-standing floor exhibits, or free-standing equipment will be permitted without prior approval. Preference of space assignments will be given to previous educational sponsors and exhibitors.

### Application Deadline

The Deadline for receipt of the applications is **Monday, August 10, 2026**. Exhibitors wishing to avoid assignment of space adjacent to a particular competitor should indicate this on their application. Careful consideration will be given to such requests. ### Exhibitor Registration/Badge Policy

All participants affiliated with exhibits must be registered. Each person will be issued an exhibitor badge and must be employed by the exhibiting company or have a direct business affiliation. Exhibiting companies are allotted 3 complimentary badges. Additional badges are \$300.

### Installation/Dismantling

The Exhibit Hall will be located in the French Ballroom and will be available for set-up beginning 8:00 am on Thursday, September 17, 2026. All exhibits must be set by 11:30am prior to the official start of the program at 1:00pm. Assembly of exhibits during the regularly scheduled exhibit hours will not be permitted. The MVSS Program Committee requests that all exhibits remain intact until the official closing time of 4:00 pm on Friday, September 18. An afternoon Break is scheduled from 3:30-4:00 pm, and exhibits should not be dismantled or removed – in whole or in part – before the end of the break. Exhibitors have until 8:00pm to pack-up and remove their exhibit. Companies tearing down and leaving prior to the official closing of exhibits will lose priority placement for future years.

### Payment

A 50% deposit of the contracted space should be forwarded with the application form. The balance must be paid by **Monday, August 3, 2026**.

### Accessibility

Cost is \$58 per night with in and out privileges and validated for up until 2pm day of check-out with validation of your self-parking ticket at the front desk.

### Travel & Transportation

Fly into Chicago O'Hare Airport. The hotel is 17 miles from the airport.

There are many ways passengers can get to and from O'Hare International Airport.

**Public transportation** such as the CTA "L" trains and Metra offer up easy and economical travel. The CTA Blue Line station is located right within the airport offering easy access for passengers. A number of airport shuttles and regional buses service O'Hare, offering transportation for passengers in the city, suburbs and surrounding states.

**Taxis, limos and rideshare** companies are all accessible to passengers that are both coming and going. There are also many rental car companies that service O'Hare.

For passengers getting to and from the airport on their own, O'Hare offers up a variety of parking options. The Main Garage features both hourly and daily parking, while the economy lots feature lower rates for travelers with extended stays. ## RULES & REGULATIONS

### CONDUCT OF EXHIBITS

The Midwestern Vascular Surgical Society reserves the right to restrict the operation of, or evict completely, any exhibit which, in its sole opinion, detracts from the general character of the exhibit program and exhibition as a whole. This includes but is not limited to an exhibitor which, because of noise, flashing lights, method of operation, display of unsuitable material, are determined by the Society to be objectionable to the successful conduct of the exposition as a whole. No drawings, raffles or quiz-type contests of any type will be permitted. Electrical or other mechanical apparatus must be muffled so noise does not interfere with other exhibitors. Character of the exhibits is subject to approval of the Society. The right is reserved to refuse applications not meeting standards required or expected, as well as the right to curtail exhibits or parts of exhibits which reflect against the character of the meeting.

### DIRECT SALES

No retail sales are permitted within the exhibit area at any time, but orders may be taken.

### SOCIAL ACTIVITIES/UNOFFICIAL EVENTS\*\*\*

The Midwestern Vascular Surgical Society will coordinate scheduling and space release for exhibitor meetings. No functions may be scheduled to conflict with the MVSS Annual Meeting, including scientific sessions, dedicated company symposia (available for sponsorship), exhibit program and any Society social events scheduled on Friday evenings. Companies wishing to invite meeting attendees to restaurants or other functions must do so following the official conclusion of any and all of these MVSS events.

### FIRE PROTECTION

All materials used in the exhibit area must be flame-proofed and fire-resistant in order to conform to the local fire ordinances and in accordance with regulations established by the local Fire Department. Crepe paper or corrugated paper, flame-proofed or otherwise, will not be permitted. Excelsior or other paper is not to be used in crating merchandise. Display racks, signs, spotlights and special equipment must be approved before use and all displays are subject to inspection by the Fire Prevention Bureau. Any exhibit, or parts thereof, found not to be fire-proof may be dismantled. All aisles and exits must be kept clear at all times and fire stations and fire extinguisher equipment are not to be covered or obstructed.

### HAZARDOUS WASTE

Exhibitors assume responsibility for (and any liability for) removal or disposal of any material considered to be hazardous waste. Exhibitors also agree to conform to any local ordinances and regulations concerning the disposal of any and all hazardous waste. Any and all costs incurred in the removal of hazardous waste from the exhibit facility will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.

### INFRINGEMENTS

Interviews, demonstrations and the distribution of literature or samples must be made within the area assigned to the exhibitor. Canvassing or distribution of advertising matter outside the exhibit area will not be permitted. Distribution of material within the hotel is not permitted.

### LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

The exhibitor assumes entire responsibility and hereby agrees to protect, indemnify, defend and save the Midwestern Vascular Surgical Society, The Drake Hotel, and its officers, employees and agents, harmless against all claims, losses or damages to persons or property, governmental charges or fines and attorney fees arising out of or caused by exhibitor installation, removal, maintenance, occupancy or use of the exhibition premises or a part thereof, excluding any such liability caused by the sole negligence, gross negligence or willful misconduct of the Midwestern Vascular Surgical Society, The Drake Hotel, its employees and agents. Exhibitor acknowledges that the Midwestern Vascular Surgical Society and The Drake Hotel do not maintain insurance covering the exhibitor's property and thus it is the sole responsibility and obligation of the exhibitor to obtain business interruption and property damage insurance covering such losses by exhibitor. The Midwestern Vascular Surgical Society and The Drake Hotel are not responsible for theft, loss or damage that may occur and advise each exhibitor to insure their stands, equipment and material at full value.
